What is Home Share?

- Home Share is available through a referral by Community Living British Columbia (CLBC).
- Home Sharing is when someone eligible for CLBC funding lives in a home together with someone who is paid to provide support: a Home Share Provider.
- We match you with a Home Share Provider who can offer you a desirable living situation that's suited to your needs and independence.
- Your future home can be chosen according to what suits you best...
 - ◊ a room in a family home
 - ◊ a suite in a family home
 - ◊ living with a roommate in a self-contained suite
